STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to incorporate the Augusta Hotel Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. In order to enable the Augusta Hotel 2 Association to redeem its real and personal property 3 from the mortgages thereon, the directors are author-4 ized to assess on the several shares of stock the just 5 proportion of the amount due on said mortgages, and 6 certify the same to the treasurer of said association, 7 and he shall as soon as practicable, demand payment 8 thereof of the holder of said stock for the time being, 9 in person if in the city of Augusta, or by letter if not; 10 and unless such assessment is paid in thirty days after

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11 demand, the delinquent shares shall be sold at auction 12 by said treasurer, after publishing notice thereof in 13 some newspaper printed in Augusta, three weeks suc-14 cessively prior to the time of sale, and posting written 15 notices thereof in two public and conspicuous places in 16 said city.

SECT. 2. The city of Augusta is hereby authorized 2 to raise money by loan or otherwise, by vote of the 3 city council, to pay the assessment on the shares held 4 by said city.

SECT. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with 2 this act are hereby repealed.
