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STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section six of chapter one hundred and thirty-five of the revised statutes, relating to removing convicts from the county jails to the state prison.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section six of said chapter one hundred and thirty-2 five is hereby amended by adding the following words, 3 viz: "And shall at the same time provide the convict 4 with comfortable and decent clothing in which he may 5 be removed to the state prison," so that the section as 6 amended shall read as follows:—When a convict is 7 sentenced to confinement in the state prison, such clerk 8 shall make out a warrant under seal of the court, di-

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9 rected to the warden of the prison, requiring him to 10 cause such convict without needless delay to be re-11 moved from the county jail to the state prison; and 12 the warden and all sheriffs and jail keepers are re-13 quired strictly to obey its directions; and the clerk, as 14 soon as may be, shall deliver such warrant to the 15 sheriff of the county, and he shall forthwith deliver it 16 to said warden, and shall at the same time provide the 17 convict with comfortable and decent clothing in which 18 he may be removed to the state prison.
