STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT authorizing the town of Newport to take stock in the Newport Manufacturing Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The town of Newport, in the county of 2 Penobscot, is hereby authorized in its corporate capac-3 ity to subscribe for and take stock in the Newport 4 Manufacturing Company to an amount not exceeding 5 ten thousand dollars. And said town is further au-6 thorized to donate to said company an amount of 7 money or other property not exceeding five thousand 8 dollars, to be paid to said company at such times and 9 in such manner as the town may determine.

SECT. 2. Said town is authorized and empowered to 2 raise and assess upon the polls and estates in said

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3 town, as other taxes are assessed, whatever sums of 4 money may be required for the purposes specified in 5 section one.

SECT. 3. The authority above given to said town is 2 not to be exercised until so determined by a two-thirds 3 vote of the legal voters of said town present and vot-4 ing at a meeting called for this purpose.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its 2 approval by the governor.
