STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE of sympathy with the Cretans in their struggle for independence.

Resolved, That the people of the United States having secured to themselves the blessings of free government at the price of a revolutionary war, feel the greatest interest in other peoples who are struggling against oppression for their independence.

Resolved, That the people of this state recognize in the heroic efforts of the inhabitants of the Island of Crete, to throw off the intolerable yoke of Turkish oppression, the struggle of Christianity against Mahometanism, and the endeavor of a brave people to secure for themselves and their posterity the blessings of a free government.
