STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for a hydrographic survey of the rivers of this state.

Resolved, That the governor, with the advice of the 2 council, is hereby authorized to appoint three commis-

3 sioners to have charge of a hydrographic survey of the

4 state. Said commissioners shall have authority to

5 employ competent engineers to make a thorough hydro-

6 graphic survey of such of our rivers as they shall deem

7 most advisable, and make a report to the governor and

8 council of the fall and volume of water of said rivers,

9 the supply and constancy of the water, their lake

10 reservoirs and their accessibility, and such other facts

11 as will tend to show their advantages for the employ-

12 ment of manufacturing industry.

Resolved, That the governor and council are hereby

- 2 authorized to cause the report of said commissioners to
- 3 be printed in such form as will be suitable for distri-
- 4 bution in other states and countries, with a view to
- 5 invite immigration and the investment of capital in the
- 6 development of our manufacturing resources.

Resolved, That the governor and council shall allow 2 such compensation for the travelling and other neces3 sary expenses of said commissioners, not exceeding 4 the sum of three hundred dollars, as shall be just and 5 equitable, and that the sum of three thousand dollars 6 be appropriated for the payment of expenses employed 7 in this survey, for which sums the governor is hereby 8 authorized to draw his warrant on the treasury.
