STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to continue in force "an act authorizing pensions for disabled soldiers and seamen."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Chapter forty-eight of the public laws
- 2 of eighteen hundred and sixty-six, entitled "an act
- 3 authorizing pensions for disabled soldiers and seamen,"
- 4 shall be and is hereby continued in force for the term
- 5 of one year from and after the twenty-third day of
- 6 February, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred
- 7 and sixty-seven.

Sect. 2. This act shall be in force from and after 2 its approval.
