
AN ACT additional to chapter one hundred seventeen of the public laws of eighteen hundred fifty-nine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter one hundred seventeen of the

- 2 public laws of eighteen hundred fifty-nine, is hereby
- 3 amended by striking out in the second line of said
- 4 section the words "one hundred and fifty" and insert-
- 5 ing instead thereof the words "two hundred," so that
- 6 the first paragraph of said section as amended shall
- 7 read as follows: Each member of the senate and house
- 8 of representatives shall be paid a salary of two hun-
- 9 dred dollars for the regular annual session of the legis-
- 10 lature to which he shall have been elected.
