STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to an act entitled an act to establish the Bangor Female Orphan Asylum, approved April first, eighteen hundred and thirty-six, and acts additional thereto.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The name of the "Children's Home of 2 Bangor" is hereby changed to that of the Bangor 3 Home for Children and Soldiers' Orphans, and under 4 that name said corporation shall have, hold and enjoy 5 all the rights and powers and be subject to all the du- 6 ties and obligations of said "Children's Home of 7 Bangor."

SECT. 2. Section one of the act to which this is ad- 2 ditional, approved April first, eighteen hundred and

3 thirty-six, is hereby amended so that the charitable
4 objects of said corporation shall include the orphans of
5 officers, soldiers, marines and seamen who have en-
6 tered the service of the United States from Maine
7 during the war for the suppression of the rebellion,
8 and have died in said service or subsequently from
9 wounds or injuries received or disease contracted while
10 in said service.

SECT. 3. If the aforesaid corporation shall within
2 two years raise the sum of fifteen thousand dollars,
3 and shall exhibit satisfactory evidence to the governor
4 and council that the same is duly and permanently
5 secured for the purposes named in this act, then the
6 governor shall be and hereby is authorized to draw his
7 warrant on the state treasurer for the sum of two thou-
8 sand dollars annually in favor of said corporation, to
9 be by them applied to carry out the objects herein
10 named.

SECT. 4. There shall be chosen annually, for the
2 government of said home, seven trustees, three of
3 whom shall be selected and appointed by the governor
4 and council, and four by said corporation, and the said
5 trustees shall receive no compensation for their ser-
6 vices.

SECT. 5. The trustees shall annually elect one of
2 their number to be president of the board. They shall

3 appoint a clerk and treasurer, both of whom shall be
4 sworn and shall hold their offices at the pleasure of the
5 trustees. The clerk shall record all proceedings of the
6 board, and copies of their records certified by him shall
7 be evidence in which the originals might be used.
8 The treasurer shall be required to give bonds and to
9 renew the same whenever the trustees shall require,
10 and to the satisfaction of said trustees.
