#### To the Legislature of Maine:

In compliance with the 5th section of chapter 25 of the public acts, approved March 13th, 1861, I submit the following Report :

Nine volumes have been lost the past year.

The means available for the increase of the Library, and for incidental expenses, during the year ending Dec. 31, 1867, were the balance from the previous year of twenty-nine dollars and seventyfive cents, and the appropriations of nine hundred dollars, making a total amount of nine hundred twenty-nine dollars and seventyfive cents.

The expenditure for the purchase of books for the Library, and incidental expenses, for the same period, has been nine hundred seventy-two dollars and fifty cents.

The entire accessions from all sources since the last Report have been seven hundred and fifty-eight volumes and pamphlets; a list of which is added to this Report.

Several thousand volumes have been added to the Library since the publication of the catalogue of 1862. The supplement to that catalogue, authorized and directed to be made by the Legislature at its last session, has been completed and will soon be printed. It contains properly classified lists of all additions to the Library since 1862.

I have continued the policy of former years in filling incomplete sets of valuable works, by purchase, when not obtainable by exchange, as far as has been consistent with the limited means at command; and in the general selection of books, have had the benefit of the mature and varied learning of our present chief magistrate, who has demonstrated the existing harmony between the just administrator of public affairs, and the profound and graceful scholar.

Under ordinary financial conditions, I should not hesitate to suggest the increase of appropriations for the enlargement of the Library, but at a time when inevitable public expenses are pressing

heavily upon the people, I deem it more prudent to leave this subject to the judgment of the Legislature, without any recommendation.

I can have no doubt that the interests of education will be well considered by them, and all will be done which the present exigencies permit.

Our State Library has already become valuable in its several departments, and we may refer with just pride to its present condition. But it is only the nucleus of what its friends hope it will become, an expanded and fully developed repository of the best learning of the age.

While economy and retrenchment in our expenditures, are imperatively necessary, I indulge the belief that it will be thought prudent to give a generous support to this institution as one of the potent means to advance the general prosperity of the State. The subject of education is too well understood to need explanation, and the advantages of a well furnished State Library are too well known to this Legislature to need elucidation.

In your care, I hope, with confidence for its future prosperity.
