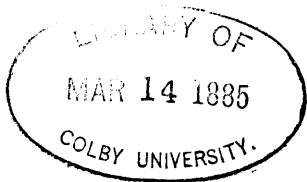

To the Governor and Council:

I have the honor to submit the following report of the business of this office for the preceding year.

LITIGATION.

The suit against the Portland, Saco and Portsmouth Railroad Company has been adjusted and the entire tax of \$12,000 and interest paid the State Treasurer.

The proceedings against the Grand Trunk Railway Company of Canada, to recover the taxes due the State are still pending in the United States Circuit Court.

The suit against the Androscoggin Railroad Company is now pending before the Law Court upon questions of law.

The suit instituted by the Home Insurance Company of New York relating to the taxation of insurance companies, and now pending in the Supreme Court of the State, will probably be adjusted.

Several suits have been commenced against corporations for neglect to make the returns required by law, and in some cases, proceedings are now pending.

CRIMINAL BUSINESS.

Joseph Henderson was tried in Somerset county at the December term, 1882, for the murder of William McDaniel. The prisoner was defended by Messrs. Walton and Walton of the Somerset bar. The jury found the respondent guilty of murder.

At the last September term of the Court in Aroostook county, John Swanback was tried for the murder of John Hanson of Chapman plantation. The defence was conducted by Hon. Llewellyn

Powers of Houlton. The cause of the State was admirably prepared by Charles P. Allen, Esq., County Attorney of Aroostook county.

The jury found the prisoner guilty of manslaughter.

The case of Sergeant Kelly of the United States army, indicted for the murder of Frank A. Smith at Fort Popham, is before the Law Court upon questions of law relating to jurisdiction.

During the year several most brutal murders have been committed. The frequency of these crimes admonishes us that the laws must be most vigorously enforced. Arrests have been promptly made and the criminals now await their trial.

The amount of the criminal business in the different counties will be found in the accompanying tables.

Table A embraces a list of the cases disposed of in the Law Court.

The business and correspondence of this office with the officials of the State Government will be found upon the files of the different departments.
