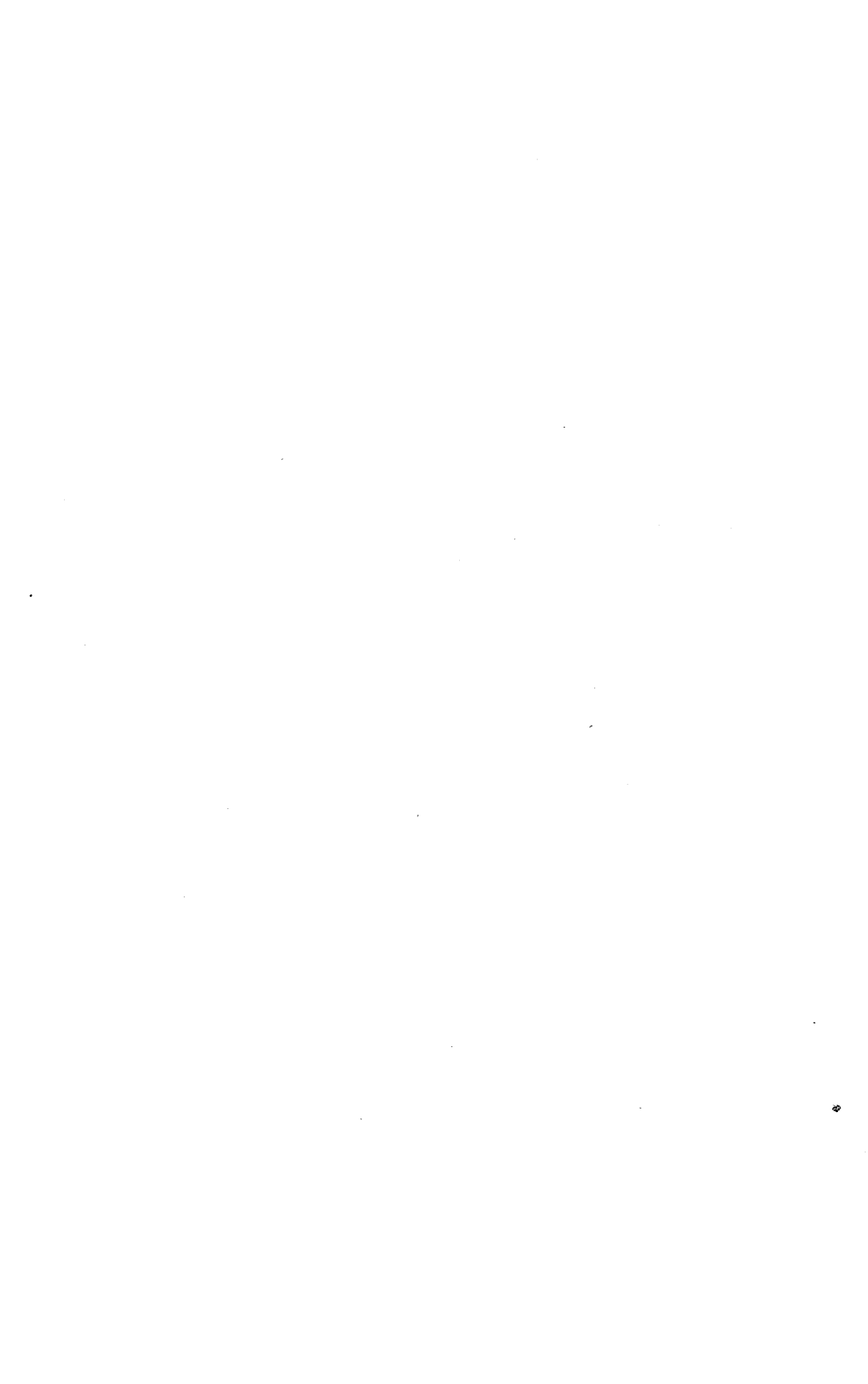

The Rules and Regulations

RELATIVE TO THE

MAINE STATE LIBRARY.

I. The State Library shall be under the management and control of the Governor and Council as a board of trustees.

II. The Library shall be kept open every day in the year, Sundays and the usual holidays excepted, during the usual business hours.

III. Books may be taken from the Library by the Governor, Members of the Council, and of the Legislature, Judges of the Judicial Courts, Secretary of State, Deputy Secretary of State, Treasurer of State, Adjutant General, Attorney General, Land Agent, Reporter of Decisions, Counsel engaged in argument of causes before the Law Courts in the Middle District, Superintendent of Public Buildings, Superintendent of Common Schools, Superintendent of the Insane Hospital, Chaplains, Secretary and Assistant Secretary of the Senate, Chaplains, Clerk and Assistant Clerk of the House, Secretary and Members of the Board of Agriculture during the session of the Board; provided that this privilege to the members of the Legislature, and those officially connected therewith, shall be limited to the time the Legislature shall be in session.

IV. Any person taking books from the Library shall first give sufficient personal security for their return within twenty days.

V. No person authorized to take books from the Library shall be permitted to have at any one time more than three volumes, nor shall the same be retained more than three weeks, and all shall be returned on or before the first day of January, annually.

VI. The following books shall not be taken from the Library room, except for the use of either House, or of the committees of the Legislature during its session, or for use in the Supreme Judicial Court in term time: all books presented by the United States or any of the States; all works, books and documents relating to the laws or legislative proceedings of the United States, or other States or countries; all digests, reports of decisions, and works relating to the science of the law, and Vattemare's exchanges.

VII. Every person shall be answerable for all damage done by him to any book, and in case of the loss of any volume belonging to a set, the person answerable therefor shall procure a new volume or pay in money the value of the set.

VIII. Any member of the Legislature having in his possession any book, map, or other publication belonging to the Library, shall return the same four days before the adjournment of the Legislature.

IX. All such books, maps, and other publications as the Governor and Council shall determine are necessary always to be kept in the Library as books of reference, shall at no time be taken therefrom.

X. All persons wishing to take books, pamphlets, or maps from the State Library, are required to report to the Librarian the title of such books, pamphlets or maps, before taking the same from the Library rooms.

REPORT.

STATE LIBRARY, }

To the Legislature of Maine.

In compliance with the laws of the State, I have the honor to submit the following report and lists of additions made to the State Library during the years 1885-86.

The amount received by appropriation for the years 1885 and 1886 was one thousand dollars for each year. For the year 1885 the whole amount was expended for books and incidental expenses. For the year 1886 the amount expended has been nine hundred and thirteen dollars and seventy-seven cents, leaving unexpended a balance of eighty-six dollars and thirteen cents for the use of the Library until the next appropriation can be made available.

A large part of this amount will be required in payment for books already ordered.

The expenses of the Library for the past two years have been adjusted by the Trustees, and the vouchers for books etc., are on file in the office of the Secretary of State.

The catalogue of accessions, submitted herewith, shows an increase of the Library during the past two years of 1,953 books and 455 pamphlets, as follows :

In the above are not included publications by our own State Government such as Laws, Judicial Reports and Public Documents.

The law books purchased consist of elementary works and law reports, English and American.

For the past two years I have been giving much attention to the Law Library. You will observe that a large number of English Law Reports have been added. A large number of these were purchased in England expressly for the Library.

Law books have a more fixed and permanent value than others, and there is ordinarily but little variation in prices, unless a copy gets out of print and becomes what is called “rare” and then it often runs up to a very high figure. These books, however, were purchased at very favorable prices. We get liberal discounts from catalogue prices.

I take pleasure in calling your attention to the list of books purchased, both law and miscellaneous.

The exchanges have been carried on with the several States and territories and public institutions with very satisfactory results. We have received exchanges from all the States, save one—Kentucky. We have received nothing from that State by way of exchange. Perhaps she will make up the deficiency in the future. The attention of the State Librarian has been called to the omission. These State exchanges have become invaluable. By this means we are enabled to gain much valuable information, to learn what matters have been made the subject of judicial and legislative investigation in the several States.

I am now in communication with the librarians of several States in relation to filling some vacancies which still exist in the laws and judicial reports of their States, and am in hopes by their courtesy and assistance to have the vacancies supplied. For if there is but one report missing from a set, that will be the identical report that will be wanted.

During the late war the exchanges were discontinued with the States in rebellion. A large part of the vacancies now existing are those which have not been filled. We have done our duty in that direction. As far as I know our books have been sent to fill all such vacancies in their libraries. But some of their libraries were destroyed, and some of their books I learn are out of print, so that it has been impossible for them to complete our sets.

The miscellaneous additions are varied in character, as they must be to preserve the harmonious topical growth of the library, but in the list are embraced the most valuable books lately published, and some very rare ones.

Those entrusted with the task of selecting books for a large library, must study diligently the literature of every department of knowledge which involves an amount of labor but little understood by those who have not been engaged in similar undertakings.

I have got tired of calling attention to the imperative necessity of more and better shelving room for the books. I am rejoiced and feel to thank Governor Bodwell for so earnestly calling attention to this matter in his first message. You will do wisely to heed what he says.

In the Library we are exposed to *water* as well as *fire*. I wish the members of this present Legislature could visit the Library during a powerful southeast storm when we have to call into requisition all the dishes which can be found about the building in which to catch water. So we are flooded in storms and liable to be burned up in droughts. New streams are liable to burst in upon us at any time, so it keeps the Librarian and his assistant upon the constant *watch*. It becomes almost impossible to keep the books from getting wet, and sometimes a nice volume becomes damaged and spoiled. I sometimes find great difficulty in keeping the Ten Commandments in anything like an unfractured condition. I feel like breaking the whole lot. Now I do not object to the work or the watching, but it seems to me that the Librarian could

be better employed in the discharge of those duties that naturally and necessarily belong to him. Almost daily there are visitors at the Library studying up some topic in law, science, history, or other subject. They most always need the assistance of the Librarian, who is supposed to know where the very information which they are after may be found.

I do hope, gentlemen, you will give this subject your serious consideration. I have been connected with this State Library for quite a long time. It is the desire of my heart to see a suitable building or suitable rooms furnished for the Library. Should then like to see the books all displayed in proper order and in proper divisions with a catalogue to match, then I would say with Simeon of old, "now lettest thou the servant depart in peace."

In conclusion, allow me to say our kindly acknowledgments are due to Governor Robie and his Executive Council for their advice in matters pertaining to the Library. They have ever manifested a deep interest in its welfare. The Librarian has received much "aid and comfort" in his labors from them. Our thanks are due, also, to all those who have so generously contributed valuable books and documents to the Library. We earnestly solicit a continuation of such favors.

During the past two years I have had the assistance of Mrs. Hobbs in the Library. Of her work and efficiency in keeping everything in order, modesty forbids me to speak.

I will say, however, that we have done what we could, under the circumstances, to keep the Library in the best condition possible. A great deal of our life work seems to be in connection with the State Library. I hope we have been of some service to the State and *squarely* earned our very modest salaries.

Let us all, in our different spheres, meet the demands upon us in a spirit of saving power to all the institutions of the State. Gentlemen, I believe there is one unfailing rule of action, which, if we will follow, will make us happy and our mission the noblest in the earth. That rule is to always be on the side of humanity, the truth and the right, "and when

we think whose words are best remembered in all the pages of Song and Story we cannot mistake the lesson. Glance through or study the literature of a country, and a part of it shall be free and cheerful as bird songs, and sweet and tender and loving as a prayer, *because pure and patriotic.*"

I now commend to your favorable consideration the Maine State Library.
