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# REPORT.

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LAND OFFICE, December 1, 1891.

*To the Honorable Governor and Council:*

The undersigned land agent has the honor to make the annual report of the operations of the land department for the year ending November 30, 1891.

Schedule A exhibits the conveyances to the Swedish immigrants upon surrender of their land certificates issued under the several acts "to promote immigration and facilitate the settlement of the public lands" approved March 23, 1870, February 24, 1871, February 20, 1872 and January 25, 1873. There are now nine of these certificates that have not been returned to the land office.

It can hardly be denied by any one that the Swedish colony is a success. They have proved themselves to be an industrious, frugal and honest class of citizens. I do not hear an unfriendly word spoken of them by any of our old American citizens. They are making greater effort to become Americanized than any other class of our citizens who speak a foreign language. In two or three generations they will become so thoroughly intermixed with our people that their former nationality and language will be entirely forgotten and lost.

Schedule B shows the conveyances made under resolves of the legislature.

Schedule C exhibits the sales for cash, under the direction of the Governor and Council, of islands during the past year.

Schedule D shows the sales of land for cash under the direction of the Governor and Council.

Schedule E exhibits the certificates issued to revolutionary soldiers and their widows and heirs. A few of these are still outstanding with little probability that they will ever be returned for deeds.

Schedule F shows the land under contract to settlers, and on which land certificates have been issued. There are now but thirty-seven of these certificates outstanding, representing five thousand one hundred fifteen and twenty-seven one-hundredths acres of land.

Schedule G exhibits the deeds delivered to the Madawaska settlers with date of delivery and price paid for each lot.

In accordance with the instructions of the commission appointed by the Governor under the resolve approved March 8, 1889 the land agent made six hundred fifty-nine deeds of lands in the Madawaska territory (so called), being the towns of Madawaska (Township No. 18 Range 4), Frenchville (Township No. 18 Range 5) and Fort Kent (Township No. 18 Ranges 6 and 7). Three hundred eighteen of these deeds have been delivered and paid for by the settlers. Three hundred forty-one have not been delivered or called for. The following table shows the number paid for and unpaid in each township, viz :

Sixty-five lots were not assigned to any one.

This schedule also shows deeds delivered between December 1, 1891 and February 14, 1892.

The last legislature made an appropriation "for repairs of the Trout Brook road, so called, between Patten in Penobscot county and Trout Brook in Piscataquis county, and that said appropriation shall be expended under the supervision of the land agent."

Calvin Bradford, Esq. of Patten, who was a member of the legislature of 1891, and very much interested in the road, was appointed to expend the appropriation. He expended the money as I learn in a very economical manner and made a very great improvement in the road; and what is quite remarkable in cases of this kind, he presents vouchers for every cent of the money expended without any charges for his services.

Major J. H. Cochrane is yet at work on his job draughting the copies of plans for the different County Registries. Five or six of these plan books will be bound in a few weeks and ready for delivery.

#### LAW SUITS.

Suit has been brought against the trespassers on the reserved lots in Highland plantation in accordance with instructions in resolve approved March 23, 1891. It will probably be tried in April at Bangor. It may be carried to the law court before it is decided as it is more a question of law than of fact.
