REPORT.

To the Honorable Governor and the Executive Council.

The Board of State Assessors would respectfully submit the following report:

By section 7, chapter 103, of the Acts of 1891, this Board is required to make a report to the Governor and Council of its proceedings, and include therein a tabular statement of all statistics derived from the returns from local assessors. The returns from a small number of towns have not been received. We were late in getting the blank returns into the hands of the local assessors, because our election came so late in the session of the Legislature. We hope to make some improvements in the blanks and have them in the hands of the assessors before the inventories are taken next year, so that it will not be the task it must have been this year to give the required information.

We give the tabulations of the returns as far as we have them, and while they are not as full as they might have been under more favorable circumstances, we must commend the town assessors for doing as well as they did, considering the time and other conditions of all concerned in their making.

In the case of telephone and telegraph companies, the Board apply the rate established by law to the amounts returned by the several companies, taking into consideration any circumstances or conditions affecting the value of the property.

The Board has so far held the meetings required by law in the counties of Hancock, Washington, Knox, Aroostook, Somerset and Piscataquis. We have heard all that the assessors and others interested in the several towns desired to say, and have gathered such information as we could. The testimony taken we have on file for use in making our report of equalization to the next Legislature.

At this time we shall make some suggestions as to some legislative enactment we deem important, to the end that such suggestions may engage the attention of the people and their validity or the want of it determined by them before the sessions.

We recommend the enactment of a law requiring the meeting of town assessors in county conventions, at such times and places as the Board of State Assessors may name and where they shall be present. The town assessors to bring the town tax books and answer such questions pertaining to the valuation of property in their respective towns as the Board may put to them.

We find a very wide difference in the standard of values adopted by the assessors of different towns, even in the same county. In a certain county one board sets the average value

of horses at \$24.00, while another board in the same county sets them at \$133.55. In other counties the variation is nearly as much. With cows it varies from \$10.00 to \$30.00, oxen from \$17.50 to \$70.00, sheep from \$1.00 to \$4.00, swine from \$2.00 to \$10.00. These figures all applying to averages.

Bank stock, than which we have little property with as stable and well understood market or cash value, runs from 50 per cent below par to 25 per cent above par on stocks of practically of the same market value.

The mischievous and unfair practice of placing a value less than a fair cash value pertains to a great degree. Some towns using one-half, some two-thirds, some three-fourths, some ninety per cent and some making a difference between real and personal estate in the per cent used as a standard. What is a fair cash value of the property in the several towns is the question demanding careful consideration. Is it the sum that would be realized from sale by auction? Or from sale in any given time? Or is it such a value as would commend itself to men of good judgment all the circumstances and conditions of the time being considered?

In the valuation of mill property there is a very wide difference of opinion, especially woolen mills. The knowledge of those who from interest of any kind have had opportunity to investigate the matter would lead to a far better understanding of this kind of property.

Many towns in their endeavors to help themselves, exempt from taxation by one means and another, the property of manufacturing establishments for a term of years. In several instances only the mills have been built in the towns exempting, and the owners have gone just across the river into another town to locate taxable property to very large amounts without apparently thinking of exemption. Is an enterprise which practically confesses that it cannot bear its share of the public expenses likely to prove a profitable one to locate? Does the exemption really have a very strong influence to control the location?

Under the law we have power to summon before us the local assessors and to examine them on oath. We can know little or nothing of the condition of any particular town or towns—whether their valuation is high or low, hence we cannot go into any very extended hearing of towns, and what we do hear under the present plan is of complaints from those who think their valuation excessive. While those to whom their valuation is satisfactory, are seldom represented and the inference may perhaps be fairly drawn that it might in justice be increased, but to what amount we cannot determine. It requires more than human power with the information we are able to get now to come to a satisfactory conclusion in the matter. We do know that all the property in the State is not taxed that ought to be. There will be tax dodgers as long as there are taxes to pay and when they can safely say “find my property if you can” the patriotism of the tax dodger will end with boasting and amount to little toward the maintenance of our government. If the property of a town is anywhere nearly fairly valued, to add an amount that we might be morally sure to be fair, would only add to the burdens already carried by exposed property. The great thing to be desired is the equal valuation of the property the assessor is able to find. We feel constrained to say here that he is far more diligent in his search than he has the credit of being, too diligent in very many instances for his own popularity.

Considering what we have hereinbefore suggested we think by the holding of the conventions named, that a standard of values fair and equal for all would be adopted, the question of what is a fair cash value be determined quite correctly, the practice of undervaluation be done away with, the exemption from taxation of large amounts of property stopped, a more effective system against tax dodging be devised and the whole system of taxation brought into closer touch with the people where it belongs.

More, instead of each board trying to see how much of the burden can be avoided, the discussions and understanding

arrived at in such conventions would lead to a more equal distribution thereof.

Another lack of uniformity is found in the method of valuing property, in the forms and classifications and in the book keeping systems adopted. We think that it might be well for the State to furnish all the blanks and books required in the assessment of taxes. The system would be uniform and better understood, reports more easily and thoroughly made and the cost to the State would be much less than it is in the aggregate to towns.

Next year will come the equalization, when we shall need the most exhaustive information possible. We have no powers of sight and understanding beyond those of the average of humanity except as we gain it in this particular line by reason of our opportunities to learn from those who are able to teach us, and we must rely for information upon those who have the best advantages for knowing the value of different kinds of property in the different sections of the State. We are glad to listen to all who have suggestions to make, ideas and information to offer. We are more than anxious to arrive at conclusions that shall be satisfactory because they are based on full information. The task we have before us is no easy one and we must have the co-operation of the fair minded, conservative, thinking, understanding and patriotic men of the state.

As the Board becomes better acquainted with the people and property and their conditions it will be of greater value to the State because able to make additions to and other adjustments of the state valuation such as shall be fair and bear equally. Ours is a large State progressing slowly but surely in the development of its natural resources. The duty of this Board is to increase the valuation only as it may be fairly warranted all things considered. The value of the Board depends upon the equality of the tax it imposes more than upon the amount it may increase the state valuation. It makes little difference whether the valuation is high or low if it is equally distributed.

We expect and invite criticism, we believe it will be fair. The town assessor is often criticised unfairly though perhaps without that intention. Few give them any information whatever as to the amount upon which they ought to be taxed, but many are they who complain bitterly of being over valued. Considering how much of the value of all property comes from the recognition and protection it has in our laws and institutions why in strict justice should not every dollar be reported to the assessors by the owner who knows best where and what it is. Has the one who returns no list of his property any good right to complain of the value a conscientious assessor puts upon it?

The town assessors have done more than well all things considered, in sending in their returns. Next year however, we shall expect them to be more complete and we shall do all we can to that end.

In closing we must give expression to our obligations to the officers of the counties we have visited for their kindness, to the town assessors for their candor and consideration and to all alike with whom we have come in contact for the many favors they have done us.
