REPORT.

LAND OFFICE, AUGUSTA, December 1, 1892.

To the Honorable Governor and Council:

In compliance with the provisions of the law the Land Agent presents herewith the annual report of the operations of the Land Department for the year ending November 30, 1892.

In March when I took charge of the office, I found its affairs in rather an unsatisfactory condition owing to lack of systematic indexing and arrangement of the books and papers belonging to this department.

The index to the maps and plans was not only very obscure but incorrect, but owing to other more important matters occupying my time, has *not* been changed.

The index of the records of deeds, while correct in the form in which it is made, furnishes but little information about when and to whom the State conveyed any piece of property, without a long search.

No other index of any value, excepting the one relating to settlers' lots in Aroostook county, was to be found in the office.

The surveyor's field notes were not arranged according to any system or indexed in any manner. These field notes are of very great value and should be preserved with exceeding care, yet it seems this has not been done in the past, and as a consequence very many volumes are missing. When and by whom these were taken away, is a matter of conjecture only, but if there is any way by which they could be returned

to the office, their great value would be appreciated by the large number of people wishing to retrace old lines and establish bounds. A careful index of the remaining one hundred and ten volumes has been prepared during the year, by which any data in the possession of the office can be easily found.

Inquiries are received, almost daily, with reference to the titles to small islands situated along our coast and in the large lakes and ponds of the State. From the list of islands found in the Land Agent's report of 1879 and a careful examination of all the records in this office, I have prepared a new list of all the islands that have been conveyed by the State, including those conveyed by Massachusetts before Maine became a state. The general opinion seems to be that the islands not included in this list are still the property of the State and should be so regarded, although in many instances there are pretended owners, basing their claims upon the fact that members of their family have claimed them for many years. In some instances, where improvements have been made and the land actually occupied, perhaps these claims should be recognized to a certain extent, but where there has been no actual occupancy and no improvements made, I fail to see how any valid claim against the State can be set up.

A few of these islands have been conveyed the past season as will be found in Schedule B. Sold by order of the Council.

No complete record of the location of the Reserved or School Lands, so-called, which the law provided for many years ago, can be found. In many townships there is no record of the location whatever and as a consequence a number of poor plantations are losing the benefits of the stumpage from such lots which should go to support their schools as the law provides. In other townships the records are defective and have led to more or less litigation for years. One of these suits brought by the State some seven years ago has been decided in favor of the State during the past season, and in another, Grand Falls Plantation, where the

defendants are the same parties, we hope to get a favorable decision very soon.

The suit brought by order of the last legislature against trespassers on the reserved lots of Highland Plantation, I am informed has been decided favorably for the State with damages to be assessed by a referee, but at the time of writing, his report has not been received at this office.

In my judgment measures should be taken to locate the reserved lots in all the plantations and unorganized townships that are likely to be organized within a reasonable time, where at present there is no record of location, and a complete description prepared of the lots in each.

The number of unsettled claims against the Madawaska Settlers, so-called, that I found when I took charge of the office, was three hundred nineteen. This number has been increased somewhat by the assigning of a few lots occupied under the same conditions as those assigned by the commissioners, and decreased by settlement to one hundred forty-five, as shown in Schedule E. Many of these unsettled claims I hope to collect without legal process, yet there are many who refuse to settle without a law suit, giving as a reason that they have held their farms for such a length of time, they think their possessory claims will hold. I am informed that before the State purchased these lands of the proprietors in order to settle the disputes regarding ownership between them and the settlers, the occupants of the lots expressed themselves as very willing to pay any reasonable price for a good title. The State having made an appropriation for the purchase of the land itself, the price charged by the commissioners in awarding the lots, was only about the actual cost of the survey, but even this small sum many are unwilling to pay, thinking that by refusing, the claims will finally be abandoned and they will get their lots without any expense. By direction of the Governor and Council, suits have been commenced against six of these settlers and if they do not influence the others to an early settlement, it is proposed to commence other suits very soon. My impression,

from a personal knowledge of these people and their surroundings, is that as soon as they are convinced that the State means to enforce these claims a very large proportion of them will be settled. A few of these claims—possibly twenty—will eventually have to be cancelled, in my judgment, but in order to deal justly by those who have already settled, it is the opinion of the commissioners who had charge of adjusting these claims that the balance should be collected as rapidly as possible.

In the survey of these lots, great care was taken to award to each settler as nearly as possible, the land he occupied, yet in running the lines, the surveyors were obliged to make them nearly straight, and by so doing small portions of land were taken from one settler and awarded another, but enough was taken from some other part of the lot of the party who had been benefitted in the first instance and given to the one who had lost, to be in the judgment of the surveyors and commissioners a just and fair compensation. At the time, the most of the settlers were apparently satisfied, but since then as they have settled for their titles, they have either commenced or threatened prosecution against each other, and it is hoped that the next legislature will make some provision by which the people will understand they must abide by the lines as established by the surveyors.

The work of copying the Massachusetts plans of Maine towns as well as those in this office intended for the use of the several counties where the lands are located, has been nearly completed and will be forwarded to the county registries in a short time. The work has been done by Maj. J. H. Cochran in an exceedingly fine and artistic manner and reflects great credit on his abilities as a draughtsman.

It is to be regretted that there are still a large number of plans of Maine towns (over three hundred) still in the Massachusetts office of which we have no copies in this office, and as the great value of these plans to the residents of Maine is apparent to all, I hope that at the coming session of the legislature

some provision will be made by which we can have such copies.

Among the resources of this office are found a lot of notes given many years ago for stumpage and wild land. Many and perhaps all of these are doubtless of no value whatever but have been carried on the books and reported as assets from this department for many years and nothing collected. Some disposition should be made of them, the good ones collected if possible and the rest cancelled. I hope to receive some instruction regarding what disposition shall be made of them.
