ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE,
HOULTON, December 1, 1896.

To the Governor and Council of the State of Maine:

I have the honor to submit, herewith, my report of the business of this office for the two years ending on this date.

James Lewis, alias James Ellis, alias James Lewis Welch, was tried at the January term, 1895, of the Superior Court for the County of Cumberland, for the murder of Byron G. Coburn, at Gorham, December 13, 1894. The trial occupied eight days, and the jury, after being out forty-five minutes, rendered a verdict of guilty of murder in the first degree. The respondent filed exceptions and a motion for a new trial on the ground that the verdict was against law and evidence, and later a motion for a new trial on the ground of newly discovered evidence. The case was argued before the Law Court on August 5th and 6th, and a new trial granted August 9, 1895, on the ground that "the charge of the presiding justice was inadequate in some particulars, and therein might have been prejudicial to the respondent." The case came up again at the January term, 1896. No opinion had been filed. Under the circumstances, believing that the newly discovered evidence taken in connection with that offered at the trial was sufficient to raise a reasonable doubt of the respondent's guilt, on February 4, 1896, the State entered a nol pro. Hon. George M. Seiders and Fred E. Chase, Esq., conducted the defence, and the county attorney, Chas. A. True, Esq., assisted me in the trial and in the argument before the Law Court.

Dr. John E. Hughes was indicted for the murder of Mary Dunn, and tried at the January term, 1895, of the Superior Court for the county of Cumberland, and the jury disagreed. At the May term, 1895, of said court, the respondent pled guilty of manslaughter, and it being doubtful whether the evidence was sufficient to establish a case of murder the State accepted the plea, and the respondent was sentenced to pay a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00). He was defended by Symonds, Snow & Cook, and I was assisted by Chas. A. True, Esq., the county attorney.

Mary Cowan was indicted for the murder of her stepson, Willie Cowan, eight years old, at Dixmont in August, 1894, and tried at the February term, 1895, in Penobscot. The verdict was guilty of murder in the first degree, and the respondent was sentenced to imprisonment at hard labor for life. She was defended by Patrick H. Gillin, Esq., and John F. Robinson, Esq., and I was assisted by the county attorney, Chas. A. Bailey, Esq., in the preparation and trial of the case.

Joseph Gabriel and Newell Gabriel were indicted at the February term, 1895, in Penobscot, for the murder of Euacio Cammillio and Joseph Langlais near Milinocket Station, in December, 1895. These were mitigating circumstances, and the State accepted a plea of manslaughter. Newell Gabriel was sentenced to seven years and Joseph Gabriel to ten years in the State's prison. John F. Robinson, Esq., appeared for the respondents, and Chas. A. Bailey assisted me in the preparation and disposition of the cases.

The case of Clara Emma Getchell, referred to in my last report, was argued at the law term for the Western District in August, 1895. The motion for a new trial was denied, and the respondent has been sentenced to imprisonment at hard labor for life. Hon. Herbert M. Heath argued the case for the respondent before the Law Court.

In August, 1895, I appeared before the Governor and Council to represent the State at a hearing upon a petition for the pardon of David W. Stain and Oliver Cromwell, who in 1889 were convicted of the murder of J. W. Barron at Dexter in 1878.

Hon. Josiah Crosby represented the petitioners, and Thomas H. B. Pierce, Esq., appeared with me for the State. After a full hearing, occupying two days, the petition was denied.

Rose Dolley was indicted for the murder of her infant son, William Dolley, and tried at the January term, 1896, of the Superior Court in Cumberland. The respondent, before the indictment, had acknowledged her guilt, but the evidence developed at the trial showed that she had done so to shield her mother, Ellen Dolley, and that she herself was innocent of the crime charged. After the evidence was out the presiding judge upon motion of the prosecuting officers, directed the jury to return a verdict of not guilty, which they accordingly did.

Ellen Dolley was indicted at the same term for the murder of said William Dolley, and after the acquittal of Rose Dolley retracted her former plea of not guilty, and pled guilty to the indictment. Upon hearing and testimony the court determined the crime to be murder in the first degree, and the respondent was sentenced to imprisonment at hard labor for life. In both of these cases W. R. Anthoine, Esq., appeared for the respondents, and the county attorney, Chas. A. True, assisted me in the preparation, trial, and presentment of the cases for the State.

Alfred J. Hurd was indicted at the January term, 1896, in York for the murder of his father, James M. Hurd, at Biddeford, on December 7, 1895. A plea of insanity was made, and the court ordered him into the care of the superintendent of the insane hospital, to be detained and observed by him that the truth or falsity of the plea might be ascertained. The case came on for trial at the May term, 1896. Hon. Frank M. Higgins appeared for the respondent, and Hon. Willis T. Emmons, county attorney, assisted me in the preparation and trial of the case. The jury rendered a verdict of guilty of murder in the first degree, and the respondent was sentenced to imprisonment at hard labor for life.

Henry Grenier was indicted for the murder of Honore Dionne at Lewiston, June 7, 1896, and tried at the September term, 1896, in Androscoggin. After the evidence for the State was in the respondent pled guilty of manslaughter, and as there were

many mitigating circumstances this plea was accepted by the State, and the respondent sentenced to four years in the State's prison. Hon. Albert R. Savage, Thos. C. Spillane, Esq., and Max L. Lizotte, Esq., were counsel for the respondent, and the county attorney, Wilbur H. Judkins, assisted me in the preparation and trial of the case.

At the same term Joseph B. Holt was indicted for the murder of his infant child, at Mechanic Falls, and the court being notified that a plea of insanity would be made ordered him into the care of the superintendent of the insane asylum for detention and observation, as provided by law, where he now remains.
