## INTRODUCTION

This document continues the series of annual estimates of Maine's population, formerly prepared by the Division of Research and Vital Records. Estimates of the population in five age groups are given for each minor civil division (MCD) in the State of Maine. Organized MCD's are arranged in alphabetical sequence within each county, and summaries of each county are displayed as well. Some of the unorganized MCD's are clustered as a single unit of population. The clustered MCD's follow the organized minor civil divisions.

Special acknowledgement is due to the agencies which supplied some of the input data used in the preparation of these population estimates. School enrollment data was supplied by the Department of Education and Cultural Services. Housing Unit data was supplied by the State Planning Office.

Under the general guidance of Ellen Naor, Director of the Division of Data and Research, Bureau of Health Planning and Development, this report was produced by Dale Welch, Senior Researcher. William Turner, Computer Programmer, prepared the input computer files and William Perry, Deputy Division Director, provided technical assistance and consultation in implementing the statistical methodology.

## HIGHLIGHTS

### Total Population:

The population of the State of Maine on July 1, 1981, was 1,132,849. This is an increase of 7,822 or 0.7 percent since April 1, 1980. Of this change, 93.6 percent is due to natural increase, which is the difference between births and deaths. The remaining 3.7 percent of change represents net migration, i.e., the difference between in-migration and out-migration. The number of in-migrants exceeded the out-migrants by 288.

### County Populations:

All counties except Washington, Aroostook, Sagadahoc and Oxford increased in population between April 1, 1980, and July 1, 1981. The largest increase in county population was 3,137 in York County. The largest decrease was a reduction of 630 people in Washington County.

Seven of the 16 counties had a net migration outward. The largest net migration outward was 1,235 in Aroostook County. The largest net migration inward was 2,184 in York County.

### Minor Civil Division Populations:

Over half (59.0 percent) of the 536 MCD's had an increase in population. The largest increases in population were in the minor civil divisions of Sanford (535), Limestone (489) and Bangor (480). The largest decreases in population were in Portland (-487), Orono (-425) and Waterville (-387).

The largest amount of net migration inward was 383, in the town of Sanford. The largest amount of net migration outward was 653, in the City of Portland.

Age Group Populations:

The amount and direction of change in population from April 1, 1980, to July 1, 1981, varied among the different age groups. The age group 0-4 increased by 2,029 individuals and had a net migration inward of 650. The age group 5-17 increased by 7,225 people and had a net migration inward of 1,020. The age group 18-44 increased by 9,616 persons and had a net migration outward of 2,894. The age group 45-64 decreased 967 and had a net migration outward of 54. The age group 65+ increased by 4,369 and had a net migration inward of 1,566.

## TECHNICAL NOTES

### Methodology:

The method used to produce these estimates is a component method in which the population estimate of each age cohort of each minor civil division is equal to the 1980 census count of the cohort, plus the natural increase of that cohort, plus the estimated net migration between April 1, 1980 and July 1, 1981.

The first two components of these estimates are known data. The third component, net migration, is estimated by regression lines based on the previous decade (1970-1980). The dependent variables in this regression analysis are the migration rates of each age group in each area. The independent variables are the ratios of the difference between the actual and expected values of given symptomatic indicators of migration to the expected values. The expected values of symptomatic indicators of migration are based on United States trends. After the estimated migration rate of a given cohort of a given MCD is calculated, it is multiplied by the population base of the cohort to obtain the estimated net migration.

Ten variables were tested for use as symptomatic indicators of migration in this methodology. They were births, deaths, AFDC children, housing units, school enrollment, newlyweds, covered employment, old age assistance recipients, military enlistments and voter registration. The best three variables for each age group were selected for use as estimators of migration. Housing units, births and newlyweds were selected for the age cohort 0-4. School enrollment, births, and housing units were used for the age cohort 5-17. School enrollment, housing units, and newlyweds were the best for the age cohort 18-44. School enrollment, newlyweds, and deaths were used for the age cohort 45-64. School enrollment, deaths and births were selected for the age cohort 65+.



#### Accuracy of Estimates:

Even if one had the perfect methodology for estimating population, the quality of the estimates is limited by the quality of the data used to prepare them. The most important symptomatic indicator of migration is the school enrollment data. There are a number of towns in which certain private schools did not report 1981 school enrollment data to the Department of Education and Cultural Services. Therefore, it is very likely that the estimates for these towns are understated. Specific examples are Kennebunk, Kennebunkport, and Arundel.

In future years, it is hoped that more complete reporting of private school enrollment can be obtained in order to optimize the quality of population estimates.
