Dear Senator Schneider, Representative Barstow and Members of the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government,


Pursuant to 5 MRSA §12009, sub-§2, enclosed is the annual report which contains a summary of the activities of boards and commissions in 2006 and the cost of these boards and commissions to State Government. This report covers 262 entities in the statutory list of boards and commissions found in Title 5, Chapter 379.

The total cost, reported to date, in 2006 for per diem and expenses for boards and commissions is \$502,485.42. This figure does not include the cost of executive staff operations for those boards and commissions that have such staffing. I have included separate reports for those boards and commissions which:

1. Filed an annual report for 2006 indicating activity in 2006 (white section);
2. Filed an annual report for 2006 indicating inactivity or no meeting of the board or commission in 2006 (blue section); and
