SUBJECT: Bargaining Unit Clarification Decisions

In accordance with Public Law 1995, Chapter 395, Part F, Section G-12, the following detail is provided for the employer cost of the pick-up retirement from unit clarification decisions of the Maine Labor Relations Board that result in the determination of positions as confidential.

The only subjects of unit clarification since the last report were three Regional Director positions at the Department of Environmental Protection. These positions were already excluded and remained so as a result of the Maine Labor Relations Board's decision. Thus there was no additional cost of the State.

We are hopeful that we will process more cases this year than in the past. This year it is estimated that between ten and fifteen positions will be removed from bargaining units.
