We are also required to submit the number of physician disciplinary actions tabulated by the Federation of State Medical Boards (FSMB). This year they tabulated 29 actions. The FSMB system tabulates a reduction in discipline as a new action, breaks some disciplines into multiple reports, and does not count physician assistant (PA) disciplines. This makes reconciliation with Board actions very complicated.


