SUMMARY: Title of bill is self-explanatory.

72 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE WORDING Pouliot (ONTP) ON QUESTIONS SUBMITTED TO THE PUBLIC AT THE POLLS

SUMMARY: Would have required ballot questions to be set out in clear, concise and direct language which may be easily understood by the voters. One of several bills dealing with this issue which the Committee addressed through LD 1059.

- SUMMARY: Would have required posters setting out the full text of constitutional resolutions and other statewide referenda to be displayed at voting places.
- COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-253): Required only that "materials" setting out the full text be posted. (ADOPTED)
