SUMMARY: Allows an engineer, in lieu of an architect, to act as prime professional in any project involving the Maine State Housing Authority.

Pharmacists

- SUMMARY: Reduces from 10 years to 5 years the practical experience requirement for a pharmacist to be appointed to the Board of Commissioners of the Profession of Pharmacy.
