- SUMMARY: Lowers the percentage of mark-up on products manufactured by a Maine licensee.

- SUMMARY: Establishes discount state liquor stores in Sanford and Fryeburg as well as in Kittery, the location of the present discount store.
- COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-40): Establishes a fourth discount store in Rumford. (min. rept.)
- SENATE AMENDMENT "A" (S-20): Lowers all state liquor store prices to the discount prices now is effect at the Kittery store. (Baldacci) (H/S:adopted)
- HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to Comm. Amendment "A" (H-62): Establishes additional discount stores in Rumford and Jackman. (Rotondi)
- HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to Senate Amendment "A" (H-69): Adds fiscal note that Senate Amendment will result in loss of \$11 million annually. (Cox) (H/S: adopted)
- 332AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR SPECIAL EX-BeaulieuONTPCEPTION AGENCY LIQUOR STORES IN COM-H/S:Acc.MUNITIES OF OVER 30,000 POPULATION
- SUMMARY: The State Liquor Commission may license additional agency liquor stores within less than a 10-mile radius of an existing store in cities of over 30,000 inhabitants if it finds there are significant numbers of people who cannot reach an existing store.
