437 AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CON- Ingraham LV/WD  
FORMITY WITH THE UNITED  
STATES INTERNAL REVENUE  
CODE

SUMMARY: Would provide permanent conformity at 12/31/82 date. Held over  
from 1st Regular Session.

418 AN ACT TEMPORARILY REDUCING Higgins, H LV/WD  
THE EXCISE TAX ON INTERNAL  
COMBUSTION ENGINE FUEL EN-  
HANCED WITH ETHANOL

SUMMARY: Fuel tax exemption (4 cents per gallon) for ethanol enhanced  
fuel beginning in 1985, reducing one cent a year through 1989.  
Held-over from 1st Regular Session pending study by Ethanol  
Steering Committee and Office of Energy Resources.

1584 AN ACT TO REPEAL THE SALES Martin, J LV/WD  
TAX ON MEALS AND LODGING AND  
TO ESTABLISH A MEALS AND  
LODGING TAX FOR THE PURPOSE  
OF STABLIZJNG THE PROPERTY  
TAX

SUMMARY: Seven percent meals and lodging tax to replace sales tax  
increases revenue sharing to 5.75% on 1/1/84 and 6.75% on 9/1/84.  
Held-over from 1st Regular Session.
