- 820AN ACT TO DENY CERTAIN STATE FUNDSLehouxRep. A-ONIPTO ANY PERSON WHO REFUSES TO REGIS-Paradis, ERep. B.-OIPTER UNDER THE UNITED STATESTuttleH/S: Acc rep AMILITARY SELECTIVE SERVICES ACT(ONTP)
- SUMMARY: Any person required to register under the Selective Services Act who fails to do so is ineligible to participate in any state program; the Governor would determine which programs would be denied to nonregistrants.
- 840AN ACT RELATING TO WHOLESALER'S AND DantonND of LD 260TASTE-TESTING ACTIVITIES UNDER THEPL 1983LIQUOR LAWSc. 59
- SUMMARY of LD 260: Wholesaler could designate space for a retail onpremises licensee to taste test new products, which could be provided by the wholesaler.
- SUMMARY OF NEW DRAFT (LD 840): Removes taste testing laws from the definitional section, and places them in a new section; allows a wholesaler to rent space from a retailer licensed for on-premises consumption in order to invite retail licensees to taste test new products as long as the activity is open only to invited licensees or their agents and not to family, guests or the public; the wholesaler may provide the products if all taxes are paid and the remaining products are removed from the licensee's premises after the activity.

SUMMARY: Allows wholesalers or distributors to place beer and wine in the stock of licensed retail stores and maintain the stock. Withdrawn on department's statement that this is already permitted.
