729 AN ACT CONCERNING THE TAKING Livesay LV/WD OF SCALLOPS

787 AN ACT TO REGULATE STRIPED Carter ENACT. PL 250 BASS FISHING

SUMMARY: In its final form, this bill establishes the following limits on striped bass:

less than 16" in length - no taking

maximum of 4 fish per dayno limit $16^{\text{m}} - 24^{\text{m}}$

greater than 24"

SUMMARY: Enacted in new draft as LD 1486 (Resolve, chapter 26).

This resolve establishes a moratorium on new applications for fish weir licenses. Existing fish weirs or applications now pending will not be affected. The moratorium extends until July 1, 1984, and is intended to control fish weir construction until the Legislature is able to study the conflicts resulting from this situation, and propose a comprehensive solution.

1006 AN ACT TO AMEND THE WHOLESALE ENACT. PL 230 Benoi t SEAFOOD LICENSE LAW

RY: Allows for the sale in the State of scallops that have been harvested beyond the territorial waters of the State. Present law will SUMMARY: not allow a vessel rigged to fish to sell or transport species. This is a specific exemption to allow large offshore scallop fishermen to come into Maine ports and sell their scallops.
