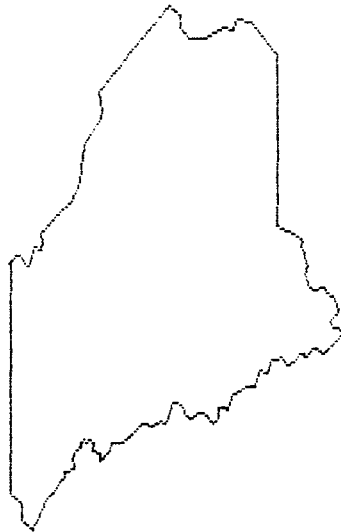

290 AN ACT REGARDING COURSES AND THEIR EQUIVALENCY OFFERED AT VARIOUS UNITS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MAINE Handy ENACT. PL 97

SUMMARY: There has been continuing controversy over the transferability of courses between campuses of the University of Maine. The bill establishes a committee to develop a uniform course numbering system and a policy to clarify and facilitate the transferability of credits. It requires the board of trustees to implement the recommendations by the fall semester of 1985.

1324 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HAZING AT POST-SECONDARY INSTITUTIONS Small ENACT. PL 159

SUMMARY: The bill defines injurious hazing and clarifies the responsibility of local campuses to establish disciplinary and appeal procedures.
