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AN ACT CONCERNING EXPLANATIONS McHenry 1059 FOR REFERENDA QUESTIONS WHICH APPEAR ON A BALLOT

- SUMMARY: Would have required that the AG's statement of intent and content for constitutional resolutions and statewide referenda include a statement of fiscal impact and be written in a manner which may be easily read and understood at the average state reading comprehension level.
- 1060 AN ACT TO PROMOTE BETTER VOTER Nadeau (LV/WD) PARTICIPATION AND TO DESIGNATE THE DAY OF THE STATE GENERAL ELECTION A STATE HOLIDAY
- SUMMARY: Would have made election day a State holiday and would have allowed any voter to vote absentee.
- AN ACT RELATING TO VOTING BY Nadeau 1180 (OTP-AM) ENACT. PL 431 CITIZENS OVERSEAS
- Requires the Secretary of State to furnish absentee ballots and SUMMARY: envelopes 20 days prior to an election. Establishes a blank absentee ballot for use by military personnel. Removes requirement that voters outside U.S. have ballot checked before voting it and eliminates requirement that the ballot be notarized.
- COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-283): Deletes the requirement that the Secretary of State provide absentee ballots 70 days before the election. (ADOPTED)
- HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-287): Would have required the clerk to type in the names of candidates who have qualified at the time a blank absentee ballot is requested.
- 1199 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT 3RD PARTIES Rolde (ONTP) FROM DISTRIBUTING POLITICAL MATERIAL ON BEHALF OF A CAN-DIDATE UNLESS AUTHORIZED TO DO SO BY THAT CANDIDATE
- Would have prohibited unauthorized campaigning on behalf of a SUMMARY: candidate and imposed penalties for violation.
- AN ACT TO RESTRICT THE TIME McHenry (LV/WD) 1200 DURING WHICH A CANDIDATE MAY CAMPAIGN BEFORE THE GENERAL ELECTION
- Would have restricted the time during which a candidate in a SUMMARY: general election may campaign to 60 days before the election.
