SUMMARY: Permits for fireworks displays must be applied for at least 10 days before the displays, rather than 15 days, to enable more sponsors to meet the requirements of the law even if they delay in applying for their permits; raises fees for permits and inspections for fireworks displays, explosives magazines, flammable liquid storage facilities, and vehicles used to transport explosives.
