SUMMARY: Permits inspection of hotel and lodging house records by all duly authorized police officers, including local police; previous law authorized only state police.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-129): Permits any full-time law enforcement officer, as defined in Title 25, §2805, to inspect records. This includes sheriffs and deputies, state police and local police and avoids concerns that part time officers would have access to private information. (H/S: Adopted)

SUMMARY: When July 4 falls on a Sunday, the following Monday would be observed as Independence Day; intended to require stores and businesses to close on July 5.
