- 1260 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE PUBLIC UTILI Kany RE-REFERRED TO TIES COMMISSION TO SET RATES ON THE Bost JUDICIARY AND BASIS OF INTERPRETATION OF FEDERAL Baker (for PUC)
- SUMMARY: Would give PUC the authority to interpret federal tax law and to take actions in conflict with federal agency policy, but not contrary to federal law.

 LITIES COMMISSION TO EXPEND H. Lewis (OTPA)
 REVENUES COLLECTED AS FILING Baker
 FEES OR EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENTS (for PUC)
- SUMMARY: A bookkeeping measure that places filing fees and expense reimbursements collected by PUC in a dedicated fund and appropriates the money from the fund to PUC. Fines and unused funds could go the General Fund.

Committee Amendment "A" (S-63) makes it clear that authorized refunds of filing fees may be made from the Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Fund. Also requires that PUC report annually on the amount and use of any such fees.

- SUMMARY: Would have increased the assessment on activities to support the regulatory fund by \$150,000 in FY 84, and \$50,000 more in FY 85. These are 11% and 3% increases. The number of positions is increased by (3) in FY 84 and (3) more in FY 85.

 UTILITIES COMMISSION TO HOLD JOINT Weymouth
 HEARINGS WITH FEDERAL PUBLIC UTILITY Baldacci
 REGULATORY BODIES (for PUC)
- SUMMARY: Authorizes PUC to hold joint hearings with federal regulatory bodies such as FERC and FCC, in addition to regulatory bodies in other states.
