SUMMARY: The bill removes PUC jurisdiction over dealers who sell liquid gas in small tanks, or to less than 10 customers from a large tank.

Committee Amendment (H-125) retains Public Utility Commission safety jurisdiction over central tanks serving more than 10 customers.

SUMMARY: Increases the debt limit of the district from \$400,000 to \$800,000.

Committee Amendment "A" (H-193) Adds a referendum if 5% of the voters, but at least 50 voters, request it.

SUMMARY: Allows railroads to use municipalities as their collection agents for railroad crossing fees.

1340 AN ACT TO CREATE AN INCENTIVE- J. Martin LV/WD PENALTY RATE BASE ADJUSTMENT Baldacci Z. Matthews McGowan (for PUC)

SUMMARY: Would have adjusted the portion of the cost of a new generating facility which is included in rate base. Only 90% of a cost overrun would be included, but 10% of any cost savings could be included. Intended to provide an incentive for cost savings on major projects, over \$100 .pa million.
