This bill corrects and clarifies language in many sections of the SUMMARY: statutes dealing with the Department of Environmental Protection. It also created a Deputy Commissioner position, extended department's construction grant program, grants sand dunes the same protection as other delicate coastal environments, addresses the decrease in Federal monies available to the department, and other changes designed to increase the effectiveness of the DEP.
