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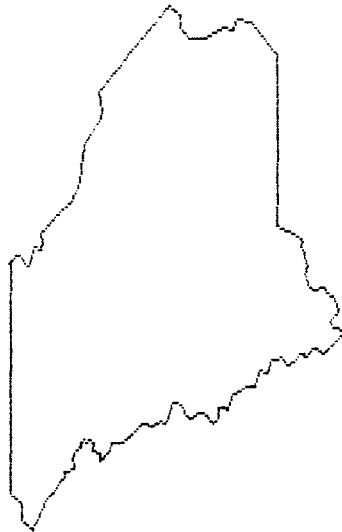

SUMMARY: The State has not adequately compensated the libraries designated as Area Reference and Resource Centers for services provided to residents from communities outside the community in which the Center is located. The bill would have allowed the centers to charge fees to non-resident users. The problem is particularly acute in Portland.
