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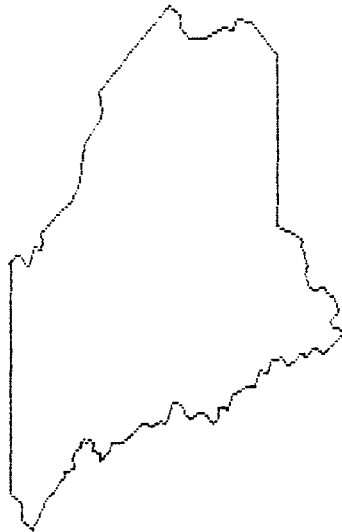

SUMMARY: The bill would have provided school boards the option of extending the probationary period for teachers from 2 to 3 years.
