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1513 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE RETURN AND PROPER DISPOSAL OF PESTICIDE CONTAINERS

SUMMARY: Requires 50 cents deposit on restricted and limited use pesticide containers to proivde an incentive for the return and proper disposal of those containers. Returned containers must be triple rinsed and upon their return, deposit is refunded. This measure seeks to eliminate the problem of dumping hazardous wastes in unsuitable areas on individual farms and tracts of land.
