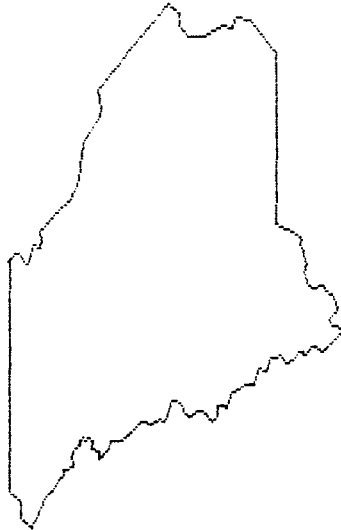

1545 AN ACT TO IDENTIFY AND TO PROMOTE EXCELLENCE IN SCHOOLS Locke LV/WD

SUMMARY: The bill would have created grants to promote excellence.

SUMMARY: Many schools now utilize volunteers to carry out non-teaching functions. The bill provides for the Department of Education to establish an office to stimulate the development of volunteer programs in schools.
