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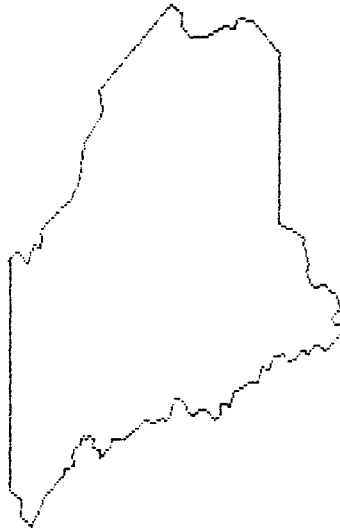

SUMMARY: Attempts to shorten fact-finding process by limiting the issues that may be presented to the panel only to controversies over cost items, and by limiting the period in which the contending parties may be heard to 90 days.
