For Limerick, it requires connection of houses within 200 feet of a public sewer, except for existing buildings with satisfactory systems. It makes explicit that interest on their bonds is tax exempt. For Jackman, it does the same.

SUMMARY: Existing law requires a utility to file 2 months advance notice if it plans to file for a certificate of public convenience and necessity for purchase of generating capacity, energy, transmission capacity, or fuel conversion. The bill allows PUC to waive that notice.
