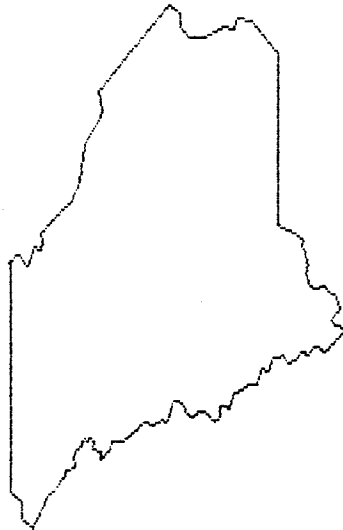

1645 AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTERS OF Vose ENACT. PL 404  
VARIOUS SEWER DISTRICTS (OTP)  
ORGANIZED UNDER THE PRIVATE  
AND SPECIAL LAWS, INCLUDING  
LIMERICK AND JACKMAN

SUMMARY: Makes changes in 2 sewer district charters. For Limerick, it requires connection of houses within 200 feet of a public sewer, except for existing buildings with satisfactory systems. It makes explicit that interest on their bonds is tax exempt. For Jackman, it does the same.

1666 AN ACT TO PERMIT EXPEDITED Vose ENACT PL 443  
PROCESSING OF PETITIONS FOR A EMER  
CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CON- (OTP)  
VENIENCE AND NECESSITY

SUMMARY: Existing law requires a utility to file 2 months advance notice if it plans to file for a certificate of public convenience and necessity for purchase of generating capacity, energy, transmission capacity, or fuel conversion. The bill allows PUC to waive that notice.

1765 AN ACT CREATING THE WISCASSET Soule HELD OVER  
WATER DISTRICT

SUMMARY: The purpose of the bill is stated in the title.
