 COMPENSATION ACT
- SUMMARY: Correlates standards for calibrating audiometric instruments set by American National Standards Institute (ANSI) with those set by its predecessor organization, the American Standards Association (ASA); also adds the words "cycles" which was omitted from current law.
- NOTE: This bill makes no changes in the actual amount of hearing loss needed to enable a worker to collect workers compensation benefits; that topic was addressed in LD 1038 which was carried over.
- APPROVED TRAINING IN THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW TO FEDERAL
 DEFINITIONS

- SUMMARY: Bill conforms Maine employment security law with federal requirement and prevents loss of federal funds; individuals participating in training under the federal Job Training Partnership Act are in "approved" training and may not be disqualified from receiving unemployment compensation.
