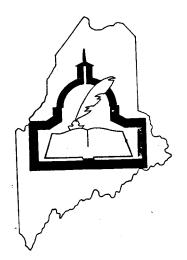

SUMMARY: Deleted requirement that certain acknowledgements be taken before a notary having a seal. A 1981 law removed the requirement that a notary have a seal. Also removed references to foreign notaries since the Uniform Acknowledgements Act already addresses that issue.

SUMMARY: The Family Abuse Law was enacted in 1980 with several sunset provisions. Parts of this law were reallocated and new sunset provisions were added, reallocated and repealed. Subsequently all of the sunset provisions were repealed except, inadvertently, the one concerning protective orders. Thus, the protective order portion of the Family Abuse Law repealed. This law reenacts those repealed provisions.
