AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR ADDI-TIONAL CONSIDERATIONS IN RE-COVERY OF COST OF CANCELLED PLANTS Ridley

LV/WD

SUMMARY: Under present law the recovery of the costs of a cancelled plant does not begin until the date when a plant was to be completed. The bill allows earlier recovery if the delay would prevent recovery of the value of these costs. The intent appears to be to consider the interest payments on the cost of the cancelled plant, and if they are too large to allow earlier recovery.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER Rotondi LV/WD OF THE JACKMAN SEWER DISTRICT Redmond TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE COMPENSA-TION FOR TRUSTEES

SUMMARY: This bill would increase the trustees compensation from \$100 per year to \$20 per meeting, with a maximum of \$500 per year. Note that 38 MRSA Sec. 1252(5) establishes a procedure for trustees' compensation to be set locally.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ELECTRIC Vose LV/WD RATE REFORM ACT REGARDING Bost ELECTRIC UTILITY FINANCING OF Matthews, Z. SUBSIDIZATION OF CAPITAL IM- Baldacci PROVEMENTS UNDERTAKEN BY RATE-PAYERS

SUMMARY: The bill allows utilities to include in their rate base the value of their investment in capital improvements undertaken by ratepayers under conservation programs which are financed or subsidized by the utility. It also provides for prompt recovery of start-up costs of such programs.

AN ACT TO PERMIT THE PUBLIC Matthew, Z. LV/WD UTILITIES COMMISSION TO AD- Kany JUST FOR CHANGES IN CAPACITY Bost CHARGES IN FUEL COST AD- Roderick JUSTMENT

SUMMARY: The bill would allow all capacity charges to be adjusted through the fuel adjustment clause. Currently, only capacity charges from small power producers and cogenerators are eligible for such treatment.
