- SUMMARY: Present law allows sales of gas to interruptible (i.e., non-firm) users at a discount below the year-round average rate normally charged. The bill allows the PUC to flow through the profits (if any) in such sales to reduce the rates of all customers.
- 1905AN ACT ALLOWING REVENUES FROMMcGowanLV/WDINTERRUPTIBLE GAS SALES TO BERidleyCREDITED TO THE COST OF GASHandy
- SUMMARY: Present law allows sales of gas to interruptible (i.e., non-firm) customers at a discount below the year-round average rate normally charged. The bill would allow PUC to include sales of gas to interruptible customers when they reconcile the actual fuel costs with the estimated fuel costs used to establish base gas rates.

- SUMMARY: The bill amends the law requiring reports to the PUC regarding insider transactions so that the penalty would apply to all violataions, rather than just violations that are willful.
