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(Committee Report) DISPOSITION PL 1983, C. 800

LD2443 AN ACT MAKING ADJUSTED ALLOCA-TIONS FROM THE HIGHWAY FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEARS ENDING JUNE 30, 1984 AND JUNE 30, 1985

SUMMARY: LD 2443, a report of the majority in new draft of LD 2121, in addition to the proposed allocations in LD 2121, increased the stipend from \$2750 per mile to \$3250 per mile paid to municipalities for road maintenance. The increase applies only to those roads maintained by the State between July 1, 1980 and June 30, 1982. The increase is effective on January 1, 1985.

1547 AN ACT RELATING TO HAZARDOUS McHenry OTP in New Draft MATERIAL PL 1983, C. 736

SUMMARY: Enacted in New Draft, LD 2198 and signed by the Governor on April 12.

1923 RESOLVE, TO NAME THE BRIDGE Teague QTP. IN HINCKLEY FOR GEORGE WALTER PL 1983, C. 53 HINCKLEY

Names the bridge between Hinckley and Clinton the "George W. Hinckley Bridge" in honor of the founder of the Good Will Home Association.

2198 AN ACT CONCERNING HAZARDOUS McHenry PL 1983, C. 736 CONTROL

SUMMARY: New Draft of carryover bill from 1st Session, LD 1547. Establishes uniform safety standards for private carriers operating intrastate which heretofore only applied to common carriers operating interstate. The Commissioner of Public Safety is now authorized to adopt those pertinent parts of 49 Code of Federal Regulations dealing with the transportation of hazardous materials establishing an effective program of control and enforcement.

2215 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE MAINE Pray OTP TURNPIKE AUTHORITY TO PERMIT PL 1983, C. 707 THE ERECTION OF KIOSKS AT REST AREAS ON THE MAINE TURNPIKE

SUMMARY: Provides legislative authorization to the Maine Turnpike Authority to establish a contract with McKean and Associates to erect a statewide kiosks system on the Maine Turnpike. Prior to enactment, the Maine Turnpike Authority had the power to grant easements for commercial purposes only to gas, service and restaurant stations.
