2248 AN ACT CONCERNING STRIPED Carter PL 1983, C. 713
BASS APRIL 9, 1984
(OIP-AM)

SUMMARY: Revises bag limit to 4 and length limits on striped bass.
Amendment HA (H-579) accepted.

2425 RESOLVE, RELATING TO Study R. 1983, C. 77
WASTEWATER TREATMENT AND APRIL 18, 1984
WATER CLASSIFICATION OF (EMERGENCY)
SARDINE PLANTS (ENG. W/O REF)

SUMMARY: Accepts a study report from DEP and the sardine industry
recommending new wastewater standards. Also supports the State
effort to petition EPA to accept the recommended standards.
Submitted pursuant to PL 1983, c. 592, sub-§1.

2475 AN ACT RELATING TO THE Vose PL 1983, C. 830
USE OF IMPLEMENTS AND DE- (EMERGENCY)
VICES IN WASHINGTON (ENG. W/O REF)
COUNTY WATERS

SUMMARY: Reenacts restrictions on fishing methods in the Pleasant River
which had been left out of a recodification of Inland Fish and
Wildlife statutes.

NOT ENACTED

1207 AN ACT CONCERNING MENHADEN Livesay CONF. COMMITTEE
FISHING IN CASCO BAY SEN ACCEPTED
HSE UNABLE TO AGREE
APRIL 12, 1984

SUMMARY: Restricts menhaden fishing in portions of Casco Bay to vessels
carrying less than 50,000 lbs. of fish. The LD was held over from
the 1st Regular Session.

1948 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A STUDY Zirnkilton (LV-WD)
OF THE SUBJECT OF A LOBSTER H&S ACCEPT
TRAP LIMIT OFF THE COAST OF
MAINE

SUMMARY: Authorizes a study of lobster trap limits. Bill given LV/WD.
Committee seeking authorization for study directly from Legislative
Council.

1968 AN ACT TO CLOSE FISHING BY Scarpino (ONIP)
MEANS OF DRAGGING IN THE LONG (MAJ ONIP)
COVE AREA IN THE TOWN OF (MIN OIP)
ST. GEORGE H&S ACCEPT ONIP

SUMMARY: Prohibits any dragging in Long Cove in the town of St. George.
The intent was to prohibit mussel dragging operations.
