SUMMARY: Replaced by LD 2312 which would have authorized the Commissioner of Agriculture to require annual tests for tuberculosis be administered to dairy animals, free of charge to the milk producer, on all Maine farms when milk enters markets where annual tuberculin tests are mandated by state law or regulation. The bill carried \$84,000 appropriation request which failed to secure required support from the Appropriations Committee.
