RESOLUTION, PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF MAINE TO PROVIDE THAT BEGINNING WITH THE PROPERTY
TAX YEAR 1984, ALL WATERCRAFT AS DEFINED BY THE LEGISLATURE SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM TAXATION AS PERSONAL PROPERTY PROVIDED THAT CERTAIN WATERCRAFT, AS DEFINED BY THE LEGISLATURE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO AN EXCISE TAX TO BE COLLECTED AND RETAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITIES.
