SUMMARY: LD 2289, a new draft of LD 1888, allows the Bicentennial Committee of Shapleigh to sell commemorative bicentennial plates which may be displayed in lieu of the front registration plate on any vehicle, resident or non-resident, <u>except</u> truck trailers.

SUMMARY: LD 2392, a new draft of LD 2160 allocates \$250,000 from the Highway Fund over the 1983-85 biennium to the Bridge Maintenance Program for the maintenance and operation of the railway portion of the Carleton Bridge. The \$250,000 will be provided to the Maine Central Railroad according to a contract between the MDOT and the MCR to be used for maintenance and operation of the bridge.
