SUMMARY: Sales tax exemption for incorporated non-profit temporary residential facilities for pediatric patients with critical illness or who are accident victims and adults with cancer and their families. Cost \$625

2432 AN ACT TO AMEND THE STATE Mitchell, J _ENACT. INCOME TAX CREDIT FOR THE PL 1983 c. 840 INSTALLATION OF RENEWABLE ENERGY SYSTEMS

SUMMARY: Reestablishes income tax credit for renewable energy systems (excluding wood furnaces) at 20% of purchase price, but not exceeding \$100. The Committee recommended raising maximum credit to \$500 but Appropriations reduced to \$100. Cost - \$45,000.

outcome of the study.
-Revises the procedure for municipalities withdrawing from LURC
jurisdiction and conditions for reassertion of LURC jurisdiction.

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
