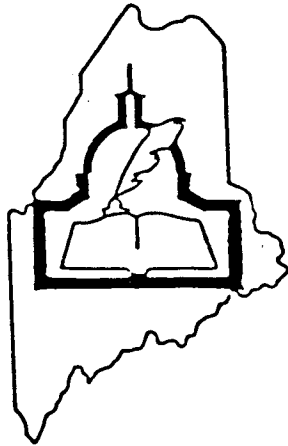

LD: 9 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE ENFORCEMENT OF PRIVATE SEPTAGE DISPOSAL SITES KANY

SUMMARY:

Current law provides that before any person may use a site for the disposal of septage, the location of the site must be approved in writing by the municipality in which it is to be located. This bill clarifies that it is the municipal officers who are to grant that approval.

SUMMARY:

The original Androscoggin Reservoir Company Charter enacted in 1909 prohibited any diversion of the river's flow from its natural channel and also prohibited the export of any electricity generated at Azischohos beyond Maine's borders, a provision that has since been found unconstitutional. LD 73 removes both prohibitions.
